SHOW HOST RULES & REGULATIONS

To be considered to host an ICBR sanctioned show, you must agree and comply with the Rules & Regulations of the ICBR Sanctioning Body. Please initial on the line located on the left-hand side of each as well as sign and print your name at the bottom to acknowledge that you have read and understand these rules/regulations. Please return this contract with your completed Show Host Application & fee. (Application and show host fee must be sent to the ICBR office BEFORE a show is added to the calendar and publicly advertised)

- The ICBR reserves the right to change rules, policies, and fees at any time without notice.
- Finding a show location is the first step to hosting a show. Each show host has a preferred location. Therefore, it is common courtesy that another show host shall respectfully not host an ICBR show at a location where an ICBR show is already being held, without the permission from that show host. RESPECT is key!
- It is the show host's responsibility to provide a safe, secure and professional show location for all patrons. For example, proper lighting, restroom facilities, security, electricity, food, parking, proper ribbons and/or trophies, no vulgar music or language, proper attire being worn by all, enough staff for admissions, registrations, and ring stewarding, etc., and above all a team of security to ensure that everyone remains safe throughout the duration of the day.
- No shows will be booked within a 400-mile radius on the same weekend. Additionally, you may not have a show in the same state the weekend before or the weekend after a previously held show in that state.
- If there are more than two shows in one day, there must be two separate rings
- The show ring should be constructed of proper material.
- Host is responsible for providing all materials needed to run registration at the event, including but not limited to armbands (numbers for show patrons), pens, copies of show entry forms, arm band numbers and rubber bands. The ICBR representative will provide the judges' books needed to record winners at the event.

- Host is responsible for providing 2 people to assist with registration of show entry. The ring steward (ICBR Rep) will be responsible for assisting the judge with ribbons/trophies, calling the classes in, making sure the flow of dogs run smooth. The rep will be in the ring recording winners in judges' books. The rep will also be overseeing the registration table.
- Fees that may apply if proper materials and staffing are unavailable and must be carried out by the ICBR representative. (Please note that the ICBR Representative may NOT offer these services, other than pre-registration) These are only emergency fees if the host does not comply with his responsibilities and will be due to the ICBR representative at the end of the event.

*Rep Fee: Please see host / rep agreement

Effective January 1, 2022, All shows having more than TWO (2) ICBR show will be required to contract TWO (2) representatives.

*Judge Fee: Please see host/judge agreement

• Show entry registration fees: Show host may charge up to a max of \$20.00 per dog per show. Show hosts may not charge more than this amount set by the ICBR. All entry fee monies belong to the show host. Only monies belonging to ICBR is the permanent registrations.

The only time ICBR would be entitled to any show fees is if ICBR host the sanctioned part of the show.

• Although it is each dog owner's responsibility to clean up after their dogs and themselves, it is the show host's responsibility to provide the materials to do so (I.E. Scoopers, buckets, trash cans, etc.). It is highly recommended to hire a clean-up crew. If a clean-up crew is not hired, the show host may have to take it upon themselves to clean up during and after the show to maintain a clean environment for the show. It is also recommended that you stress to your show patron the importance of cleaning up after themselves. A dog that is owned or co-owned by hosting kennel club, a member of said show hosts immediate family (Immediate family includes: Spouse, parent, stepparent, child, stepchild, sibling, grandchild, in-laws are also considered immediate family) cannot be shown that day.

- A dog that has been owned, has entered into a breeding contract, trained or handled by said show host/kennel club, a member of the said show host/kennel club immediate family within three months of the date of event cannot be shown that day.
- ICBR judge / representative and their immediate family, a dog that is owned, co-owned, trained, handled, or any other affiliation cannot enter or show in the ICBR conformation show that day.
- Each ICBR event will be analyzed by an ICBR member(s) or show patron that has been chosen by the ICBR that will attend the show to make sure these measures are met and up to par. A show evaluation report will be completed by above said person. This show evaluation report will only be sent to the ICBR office for ICBR to view and analyze. The show host(s) may contact ICBR ten days after their show is completed to verify that the evaluation of their show was acceptable and discuss any changes that may need to be made or any suggestions made by the person that prepared the evaluation. The ICBR member(s) or show patron that prepares the evaluation will remain anonymous. If the show standards are not met, the show host(s) will be informed of changes that must be met if they desire to host another ICBR event. If standards are not met a second time, the show host will be suspended from hosting any future ICBR events. ICBR reserves the right at any time to reject a show host application.
